April 24, 2022

- Pastor Matt & Angie welcomed everyone, and Pastor James opened in prayer
- Pastor Matt explained the budget process ~ begins in February with 12 month and 18 month forecast. The budget is reviewed by the trustees and church council.
   Angie explained the goal is to be at 60% staff to budget.
- Angie discussed 90-Day Sprints Most effective 90 day sprints so far.
  - Discipleship focus on definitions and rules to live by. Conversations to cultivate and grow it.
  - Crossroads Community Center focusing on language, structural policies. We have landed on a mission statement, in short Transforming Love = Empowering Lives. Crossroads Community Center soft launch will be June 5, 2022.
  - Staff organizational restructure finalize organizational structure and staff plan.

Last quarter I shared that we adjusted parts of our staff structure, and one of the outcomes of those adjustments was a modification to the way we execute our 90-day sprints. Previously, our sprints were primarily executed by specific leaders and their individual teams, as applicable. Our sprints have been such a success, that we have decided to implement that culture within all of our staff teams and positions.

Moving forward, rather than three sprints a quarter, you will see one main sprint for which our entire staff will have some responsibility. In addition, each team will also have their own unique sprint. The purpose of each sprint remains the same as before: to identify a measurable objective that helps us move towards our 5-year goals.

**Main Sprint: Connections Terminal.** One of the areas of ministry we know needs development is the way in which a new guest interacts within our systems, learns our culture, and gets connected into the community. We have so many new guests every weekend, and a thriving community group ministry. However, taking that step from, "I am new" to joining a CG is a large one to take. And so, we have asked Pastor Trevor, as our Connections Pastor, to lead us in identifying that pathway. What has come out of that sprint is something we are calling *Next @ Crossroads*, a fun, interactive monthly gathering where new guests can learn more about who we are, what we believe, and what they are invited into. We will be launching NEXT this fall and will begin sharing details in August.

**Team Sprints:** Our team sprints this quarter largely focused on learning how to interact with the sprint system, as well as creating and fostering culture within their newly-formed or adjusted teams.

It's been another incredible quarter of ministry. We are meeting new families every week and seeing people draw closer to Jesus at each step. It is incredible what God is doing here in our community; what an awesome blessing that we get to be along for the ride. Enjoy the rest of your summer, friends!
